Additional Scriptures: John 8:31-32, 1st Corinthians 14:24-25, Hebrews 2:3-4

Discussion Questions

- "I'm afraid we have domesticated the Holy Spirit." How have we domesticated the Holy Spirit in our lives?
 - In our relationships? Microchurch? Explain and give examples.
- How would you explain the idea of the Holy Spirit and the gifts to someone who has been turned off to the Holy Spirit and spiritual gifts in the past? Which specific Scriptures would you point them to?
- The Biblical word meaning "know" is the same word used for when a husband knows his wife... knowledge in the Bible is experiential. So this begs the questions, do you *know* the Holy Spirit? What does that look like?
- P. Mike said, "I want the whole Bible. Whatever God says is possible... I want that to be real in my life." What parts of the Bible are hard for you to believe and understand? What parts of the Holy Spirit are hard for you to process or act on in your life?
- **Read 1st Corinthians 14:25-26.** P. Mike said, "This is what the church is supposed to look like." How does this look on a Sunday service? IN your microchurch? In Starbucks, during your classes, at your work, and during the other parts of your life?
- Most people crash and burn on their first try with spiritual gifts, but with most things it takes practice! How do you practice the gifts?
 - Go through each one and give examples of how to practice them.
- Describe some times when a spiritual gift changed your life or the life of someone around you. Share a few testimonies.
- How do you figure out your spiritual gifts? What part does your microchurch or close community of friends who are believers play into that?
