Discussion Questions

- “The heavens declare the glory of God. Are you listening?” What do you think Pastor Mike meant by that?
- **Read Psalm 19:1-7.** David talks about what P. Mike called “the world book and the word book.” God has revealed Himself to all people through the world and the word. Why is it important that we see and acknowledge God in both and not just one or the other?
 - What does the Word reveal that creation does not?
 - What does creation highlight about God that may not be fully grasped by the word alone?
- Creation can inspire the heart but creation cannot change the heart. It takes a word for transformation. Can a transformative word come from another person or can it only come from the Bible? Explain.
 - Has God given you a word that has changed your life? Was it from the Bible or another person?
- **Read Psalm 19:7-11.** “True freedom isn't found in doing what you want. True freedom is finding the environment that is best for you.” How does the Word play into what P. Mike said here?
 - How do you explain to someone who does not know God that the law of God is not just a buzzkill and a downer that we are forced to have to follow?
- "It's not just wrong to do things against God's word, it is just plain stupid. Sin is not just evil... it's just stupid." What did P Mike mean by that?
- How much do you give to TV? Facebook? Twitter? Your hobbies? How much time have you given to the word and prayer? Which do you think is going to have more influence and sway over your life considering the time given to each?
 - How do we seek God and go deeper with Him without having it feel like a duty or obligation? How do we seek God without getting religious about it?
