Discussion Questions

- **Read Hebrews 5:11 – 6:12.** What are the basic tenets that Paul is talking about in this passage? Why do you think that he references these specifically as the basic tenets?
- **Read Hebrews 5:14.** You mature by putting into practice what you heard! What are some teachings that you just don't like putting into practice?
 - What are some things that are second nature in your spirituality that come naturally because of constant use?
- The best way to learn something is to reproduce it... to teach it to someone else. What are some ways that you can incorporate teaching discipleship principles in your everyday life? At school? At home? At work?
- We aren't called to be professionals before we start putting things into practice. As soon as we know anything we are called to share! Where have you said "I don't know if I am ready?" when it comes to your faith and/or sharing?
- Do you know God intimately? What does a mature, intimate relationship with the Lord look like?
 - What are some traits of a mature believer?
- **Read Hebrews 6:3 & Philippians 2:12-13.** How do you reconcile these verses? How do we rest in God, work hard, and grow in the Lord all at the same time?
- You don't get mature by trying harder but by trusting deeper. What do you think Pastor Mike meant by this? How does this play out in your walk with Jesus?
