Main Scripture: Revelation 3:14-22

Additional Scriptures: 2nd Corinthians 13:5,
Matthew 13:44-45, Colossians 2:1, Colossians 4:13-16

Hearing: Discussion Questions

- **Read Revelation 3:14-16.** Break up into smaller accountability groups and ask the following: If you were to do an honest assessment of your walk with Jesus at this point, where are the places that have become lukewarm in your walk?
 - What are some steps that you are going to take to fight against complacency?
- Pastor Matt said that what you really believe is not just your verbal theology but the way you live your life. Do you agree? Do you think that every facet of our theology can be manifested in the way you live your life? Why or why not?
- **Read Matthew 13:44-45.** Jesus is saying here that the Kingdom should be your greatest treasure worthy of giving everything else up for. How do you know if Jesus is really someone's treasure or not?
 - Are there things in your life that you are holding on to that are hindering you from making Jesus your ultimate treasure?
- Pastor Matt asked the question "Would your life look any different if you suddenly stopped believing in God?" Break down your last week and see how it would have changed if God was not a part of that equation. What would have been different?
 - Are you satisfied with the results? Would you like to see more Jesus in your week? How could Jesus be a greater part of your everyday living?
- "The travesty of the church today is that we have a lot of people in the church that want to be saved by Jesus but do not want to follow or be like Jesus." What holds us back from not being completely sold out for Jesus? What hindrances in your own life have been the biggest barriers to transformation and really praying earnestly for John 3:30 to be a reality in your life?
- Pastor Matt said "The problem with lukewarm Christians is that they want a Savior without a Lord." How would you explain how Jesus is a Savior to someone? How would you explain the idea that Jesus is Lord to a complete unbeliever?
 - What are some common places among Christians today that Jesus is not Lord of?
 - If you are honest with yourself, what areas of your life is Jesus not Lord of?

Doing: Application

- Don't just talk about changing lukewarmness... do it this week. Hold each other accountable and pray for transformation!
