**Main Scripture:** Matthew 28:16-20  
**Additional Scriptures:** 1<sup>st</sup> Peter 1:10-12

### Hearing: Discussion Questions

- **Read Matthew 28:16-20.** Pastor Mike asked the question “Is it possible that the living water is not flowing because we didn’t first go up on the mountain to worship?”
  - What is the relation between seeking the Lord and sharing the Gospel?
  - What happens when you seek the Lord but don’t share? What does that do to your spirit and walk with Christ?
  - What happens when you share but don’t seek? How does that effect you?
- Pastor Mike said that there is a clear command to GO in this passage... but the church today has turned that command into an optional call that not everyone has.
  - Do you agree with him? Why or why not?
- If we all are really called to GO, does that mean *everyone* has to go to the unreached places of the world? If not, then how do you stay in your current location but still fulfill the command laid out for us here in Matthew 28?
- Go literally means “don’t stay.” Where is God calling you to go in your personal life? Where is He saying “Don’t stay here! Go \_\_\_\_\_” ... you fill in the blank.
- Pastor Mike said that Christians should be running to the hard places, not away from them. Can you find Scripture to back this up or examples in Scriptures where this was the case?
  - Where are some “hard places” here in Gainesville that you could go to?
- “There are three responses to this command [in Matthew 28]: go, send, or disobey. Which response has been the most prominent have you given this past week, month, or year of your life?
- Mike told the story of Samara and how when she was little she said “Daddy, we have to tell them ALL!” when he was at Publix with her one day. He ended up sharing the Gospel with multiple strangers that day.
  - How do you share the Gospel with complete strangers? What works? What doesn’t? How have you seen this done effectively?

### Doing: Application

- GO this week... whether that is into the hard places in Gainesville, financially and prayerfully sending someone else to go to the unreached nations, inviting a friend to church, or whatever God has put on your heart. Come back next week and share your stories of how you were sent and the results next week at small group!
