Main Scripture: Colossians 3:1-17
Additional Scriptures: Philippians 3:8-9, Psalm 27:4,
Galatians 5:19-21, Galatians 6:8, Matthew 6:10

Hearing: Discussion Questions

- **Read Colossians 3:3-4.** We want people to be wowed by our life and who we are in Christ. Does your life expose other people to heaven, to a new way of living? How so or why not?
- Pastor Robbie said that the goal of the fullness of God is so that we can point to Jesus. What are some ways that you would like your life to point towards Jesus?
 - What are some steps that you can take to get to a place where that is happening?
- **Read Colossians 3:1-2.** How do you go about setting your heart and mind on things above?
 - What sort of things here on earth snare your thoughts, affections, and desires that keep you from setting your mind and heart on things above?
- “We must not only seek heaven but think heaven.” Pastor Robbie gave the example of the white rope that represented eternity with a tiny piece of red representing our lives here on earth. How do you move towards thinking about eternity in your everyday life?
- **Read Galatians 6:8.** What are some ways that you sow into the Spirit? What are some ways or times that you struggle with being in the flesh?
- “We never show up to a party or get together without getting ready externally (brushing your teeth, doing your hair, clothes, cologne, etc.) but we show up at all kinds of places spiritually unprepared.” Are there some environments that are harder than other for you to stay in the Spirit?
 - What are some ways to ensure that you are walking in the Spirit during those times or at those places?

Doing: Application

- We give the most attention to where we get the most feedback. Where you are getting the most feedback in your life? In your spiritual walk? Where do you need to spend more attention in your walk with Jesus?
 - Find an accountability partner in your small group that is going to ask you about that specific aspect of your faith and make an agreement to hold one another accountable in that area for the next few months.
