Main Scripture: Mark 12

Additional Scripture: Hebrews 6:1, John 15:1,
Matthew 6:19-21, 2nd Corinthians 8:1-5

Hearing: Discussion Questions

- If God were to tell a parable about your life, what would it be like?
- Pastor Robbie said that even when we are completely fruitless, we hate fruitlessness and always desire to be fruitful. Think about what kind of lifestyle you are living. Are you satisfied in your walk with Jesus?
 - What areas would you like to see fruit/growth in?
 - What areas are you doing well?
- “We cling to blessings that were meant to be fuel for the mission.” What do you think Pastor Robbie meant by that?
 - What blessings have you clung to that were meant to be fuel?
- Pastor Robbie talked about how food, facebook, your job, etc. are great servants but terrible masters. What aspects in your life are meant to be servants but have become your master? How do you get them back to servant status?
- **Read Matthew 6:19-21.** “How you spend your money shows what matters to you most.” Think about the past week, month, and year. What has the majority of your money gone to? Is that what you want mattering to you most?
- “Money doesn’t change people, it simply unmasks them.” –Henry Ford. How do you prepare yourself to be a good steward of money in a season when you are making next to nothing? How do you get your heart in a place where money does not become a master in your life?
- Pastor Robbie said that we are so calculated with our giving but so free with our spending. Why do you think that is? How can we reverse these roles in our lives?
- **Read 2nd Corinthians 8:1-5.** What was the catalyst for the Macedonian church to give so generously? How do you get to a point of giving joyfully and so generously like the Macedonian church?

Doing: Application

- Go nuts with giving this week! If you have not already, find a cause with your small group and start sacrificially raising money for that cause. If not with your small group, do it with your family and roommates. Give generously and watch how the Lord shows up and shows out!
