Discussion Questions

- **Read Hebrews 10:22-25.** How do these verses parallel our desire as a church to live in the green?
- The Bible teaches that some assembly is required. To resume heaven on earth, you need to assemble here on earth. What did P. Mike mean by that?
- How did Mike define "the church"? How is this different than the traditional understanding of what the church is?
- How did he define what a microchurch is? How does your microchurch line up to how he described it?
- *We value diversity.* God doesn't ask you to drop your culture when you gather... He asks you to bring your culture with you. How does your microchurch value diversity?
 - How do we value diversity in our everyday lives? What does that look like?
 - What are some ways that we devalue diversity (and may not even know we are doing it)?
- *We value authenticity.* Pastor Mike said we want to be known and loved, but we can't have both. Do you agree with that?
 - How can the church remedy that? What does that look like?
- Pastor Mike made a bold call for us to take off the masks we wear. If you are honest with yourself, what masks are you wearing?
- In light of authenticity, what are some of the struggles/questions you have that you have been afraid to ask or talk about?
- *We value accountability.* God loves you just the way you are... but loves you too much to let you where you are at. How does accountability play out in everyday life? Share some stories of people who really have impacted your life through accountability.
- How do you hold someone accountable if they push you away when you try?
