Hearing: Discussion Questions

- The Gospel is good news to you, then it is good news through you. How is this true in your life? How can the Gospel be good news outside of simply sharing your faith to someone?
- Pastor Mike said "If someone hasn't received it as good news, then you haven't shared the Gospel with them." What did he mean by that?
 - Does this mean that if said in the right light that the Gospel will be received as good news to everyone? Why or why not?
- How would you define the church to someone who had no idea what the church was?
 - How do those who aren't followers of Jesus view the church?
 - P. Mike described the church as "a worshipping community on mission." Do you think this is an accurate portrayal?
 - How does your microchurch portray this?
- **Read Revelation 2:7, 11, 17, 3:5, 21.** Jesus conquered. But now you are a conquerer as well. You are a changed agent that is a change agent. How does that fit into your everyday life here in Gainesville? How do you bring change in your life?
 - How does a person who works a 40 hour work week bring change that is beyond yourself?
- **Read Luke 24:47.** All of you already preach, it is just a matter of what good news you are proclaiming. What "good news" do you find yourself preaching more often than other good news? What does culture dictate is good news?
- **Read Luke 24:49 & Isaiah 61:1-2.** Even though your faith is personal, it is not private. It is NOT just for you! We are called to share what we have received. How have you stood up against injustice as a microchurch? How have you collectively or individually shared your faith?
- The church is supposed to be an enemy of the status quo. How is this true? How is this untrue? How can we make the untrue aspects true again?
