Hearing: Discussion Questions

- **Read Luke 24:52.** How did P. Mike define worship?
- You are a worshiper. The question is not if you will worship by who/what you will worship. You don't have to be religious to worship. What would you say you worship in your life?
- Follow the trial of your time, energy, money, affection, allegiance and at the end of that trial is a throne. What is on your throne is what you worship. According to this trial, does that change what you say worship?
- P. Mike talked about two aspects of worship: glory and sacrifice. What do you sacrifice for on a regular basis (sports, family, job, house projects)?
 - How much does your sacrifice for Jesus compare to your sacrifices for other things?
- **Read Luke 24:14-16.** Jesus has a way of showing up where He is talked about. Has this been true in your life? How so? Give some specific examples.
- Idolatry is worshipping the God you want instead of worshipping the God who is. Where is that true in your life?
 - What is hard for you to swallow about God and the Bible?
- **Read Luke 24:25-27.** The Bible reveals Jesus. Everything has to do with Jesus. With this in mind, we have committed that our church's first virtue is Jesus. Your first virtue dictates everything else you do. How have you seen that true in your life and in the lives of those around you?
- Pastor Mike talked about living in the green: Worship, community, mission. What is the easiest aspect of living in the green for you?
 - Where do you need to grow the most?
