Main Scripture: Colossians 1:1-2

Additional Scriptures: Colossians 2:10, 2:2-4

Discussion Questions

- Paul refutes the Gnostic teaching of needing Jesus plus secret knowledge by saying all you really need is Jesus plus *nothing*. What are some things, relationships, and spiritual extras that people “add to Jesus” today?
 - Are there any of these extras that are harder for you to avoid than others?
- “Shalom is the result of being in Christ and knowing it.” How do we go all the way and fully understand who we are in Christ? What Scriptures really point to who we are in Christ?
 - How do we walk out this truth of who we are in Christ? What does that look like day to day?
- “Get in Christ and live there.” Sometimes, we are positionally in Jesus but functionally we are not! What is the difference between Jesus as a positional and functional Savior as Pastor Mike explained?
- You don't need something new; you need to go deep with what you got! What do you think P. Mike meant by this when he was referring to the Gospel?
- **Read Colossians 1:1-2.** The problem with most Christians is that we wildly underestimate Jesus and therefore underestimate who we are. We think of ourselves as sinners and not saints. We act according to who we think we are... so why is it so important for us to know who we are?
- What you do does not define who you are: how God made you defines who you are! Go through the "Who We Are In Christ" handout that was given Sunday. What is the easiest aspect of who we are in Christ for you to acknowledge?
 - What is the most difficult for you to relate with? Why?
