



## Who is Jesus?

**Main Scripture:** Colossians 1:15-20

**Additional Scriptures:** John 14:8-9

### Discussion Questions

- Are you more known for what you are against or for what you are for? How do we ensure that what we are known for what we are for?
- When you are going through trials, the question isn't how big is your trials but how big is your God? How do we keep a high view of Jesus in the midst of hardships?
  - What are some Scriptures you lean on in the midst of trials?
- **Read Colossians 1:15-16.** How do you know that Jesus is God? Take a few minutes and find other passages of Scripture that reveals that Jesus IS God.
- Part of the heresy of the early church was that there was a sacred/secular divide and that God didn't want to touch or deal with the secular. How has this permeated our view of how we connect or are used by God today?
  - Do you differentiate between the "sacredness" of Pastor Mike's job and your own? Do you feel some vocations are holier than others? What Scriptures could you use to show that all believers are called to be ministers where they are at?

If Jesus is God then:

1. **Jesus is supreme.** You have to bow down to Him. He is Lord. You have to give Him EVERYTHING in your life. Where in your life have you not given Jesus full reign and supremacy?
2. **Jesus is sufficient.** He is more fulfilling than anyone or anything else. He has proven Himself to be absolutely trustworthy. Where do you have a hard time trusting God and believing that He is sufficient?
3. **Jesus is modest.** He will not force Himself on anyone or flaunt his power and authority. Where has this been the case in your life?
