



## **I Once Was Blind But Now I Squint**

**Main Scripture:** Mark 8

**Additional Scripture:** Romans 3:10-12

### **Hearing: Discussion Questions**

- “Everyone of us is blind.” In what ways were you blind to the Gospel of Jesus before knowing Him?
  - Where do you still struggle with spiritual blindness? What aspects of the Gospel are still hard for you to swallow? Why do you think that is?
- “Unless someone brings me and Jesus touches me, I’ll never get changed.” Which of the three Breakthrough testimonies spoke the most to you? Why?
  - Take a second and reflect who in your life you are reaching out to and bringing to Jesus. Where are you at with that pursuit?
  - What are some ways you could lead them to a place where Jesus could touch them? Pray specifically for them and for Jesus to touch and change them.
- Pastor Mike said that sin blinds you and most of the time you don’t even know it. How do we combat sin if we are blind to it and don’t even know it is going on?
- “You are not going to get fully free until you are fully honest.” What did Pastor Mike mean when he said this? Where have you not been fully honest with the Lord and what were the repercussions of that?
  - Where in your life do you need to get honest with the Lord?
- **Read Mark 8:22-26, Mark 7:24-30, and 2<sup>nd</sup> Kings 5:1-14.** Healing from God is both a moment and a journey. How is this possible? Explain the different dynamics of healing being a moment and a journey in these passages and also in your life.
  - More specifically, how is emotional healing both a moment and a journey?
  - What about spiritual healing and cleansing?
- **Read Mark 8:27-29.** Peter confesses Jesus as Lord... but what does it mean for Jesus to be Lord of your life? Explain what Lordship means.
  - If you are honest, where is Jesus not Lord of your life? Where have you not given Him complete and utter control?

### **Doing: Application**

- “Unless someone brings me and Jesus touches me, I’ll never get changed.” Pray about someone the Lord wants you bring to church this Sunday for Easter so that Jesus can touch them! Pull out all the stops and go for it!
