Main Scripture: Acts 9:1-18

Additional Scriptures: 1st Timothy 1:15-16, Acts 26:4-5, 2nd Corinthians 4:3-6 & 3:15-18

Hearing: Discussion Questions

- Pastor Mike said, “There is something about a testimony... you’re supposed to go public with it!” What is your testimony? Why is telling your testimony a vital part to evangelism? What are some circumstances or with whom could you could share your testimony in an evangelistic way?
- “God can change anything... but it is hard to break from your past.” How has this been true in your life? What are some things from your past that are holding you back? Take some time to pray through some of these past issues that you are having a hard time breaking from.
- “Watch out when your way of the faith is known more for what you are against than what you are for.” Take a moment of honest reflection and ask yourself, “What is my faith known for?” What are some steps you can take to ensure that you are being known for “the way” you live and not what you are against?
- **Read Acts 9:3.** “Now as he went on **his** way...” (ESV) Saul’s ways were radically changed by the Way. What ways of yours need changing by *the* Way?
- **Read 2nd Corinthians 3:15-18.** The secret to transformation is beholding Jesus. So what does that mean in your life? How do you behold Jesus?
 - Can this happen outside of praying and reading your Bible? How?
- Do you follow Jesus because you truly believe He is the best way to live? If someone looked at your life, how could they see that this is true?
 - What are some of the hardest aspects of following Jesus for you even though you know it is the best thing for you?
- Pastor Mike told the story about Misty Edwards and how some men thought her singleness that she consecrated to the Lord “was a waste” because she is a good looking, God fearing woman. When people look at your life, what do they see you wasting your life on? God? Your computer? Video games? Stock market? Sports?
 - What would you *like* to be known for wasting your life on?
 - What are some steps to start moving in that direction?

Doing: Application

- Start “wasting” your life for Jesus. Pray and figure out what direction you want to go in regards to wasting your life for the Lord and start taking practical steps in that direction! Incorporate sharing your testimony into that plan!
