

## **Rise Up and Eat!**

**Main Scripture:** Acts 10:1-3, 5-6, 11-15, 19-22, 24-26, 28-29, 33-35, 43

**Additional Scriptures:** 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 5:11, 13-21, John 16:33, Acts 1:8

### **Hearing: Discussion Questions**

- Pastor George talked about the biases that hindered Peter from sharing with Cornelius. What biases do you have that hinder you from sharing Jesus with people?
- “God is always up to something in people.” Even when people seem stone cold to the Gospel, God is moving and working in them. Share some stories of times you have shared with someone who you thought you had zero receptivity to the Gospel and how they opened up to it either right then or eventually.
- Before you feed the sheep, you need to *find* the sheep! What doors has the Lord opened in your life to “find sheep” and share the Gospel?
- When Pastor George asked evangelists to stand up, did you? Why or why not?
  - What reasons do you use to explain to yourself why you are not or would not be a good evangelist?
  - What other hindrances keep you from witnessing?
- “Identify the ‘God-incidences’ in your life and jump on them!” What did he mean by that? What “God-incidences” has God put in your path? How can you capitalize on those?
- Jesus met the woman at the well and turned this water fountain moment into an eternal one, which brings up the idea of being intentional. How can you become more intentional with evangelism in your everyday life?
- “The Gospel is for everyone.” If someone looked at your life, would they know that this is true? Why or why not? If not, what are some steps you could take to change that?

### **Doing: Application**

- Make sure that your small group is loaded up with VIP cards which you can get at the church. Make a commitment to pray for your VIP cards everyday this month and to try to witness to those people at least once as well.
- Hold each other accountable to not only find but to capitalize on the “God-incidences” this week.
