

## **Justice: Give What You Got**

**Main Scripture:** Philippians 2:1-4  
**Additional Scriptures:** Isaiah 1:17, Mark 12:41-44

### **Hearing: Discussion Questions**

- **Read Philippians 2:1-4.** Which part of this passage is the hardest for you to live out? Why do you think that is?
  - How can you, this week, make progress in this area?
- Pastor Matt said that transformed lives have to come from transformed hearts. Do you feel that you have the eyes and heart of Jesus when it comes to the poor, oppressed, and those who are ensnared by injustice?
  - If not, how do you go about truly getting His eyes and heart?
  - What would you tell someone who is brand new to justice issues to do in order to get activated and involved (from a place of transformation as opposed to hype)?
- “You never get more of Jesus than when you are giving Him away and you are never fuller than when you are pouring out!” In what ways are you giving Jesus away with your life?
  - What are some ways you would like to but haven’t started doing it yet?
- If you were to look back on your life so far, what would your assessment be? Would you be at peace with how you spent your life?
  - What would you want to see more of? Less of?
  - How can you make this a reality?
- What do you have right now that you are not going to have at other times in your life to give to combating injustice? How can you fully maximize these resources in our battle against evil and injustice?
- **Read Mark 12:41-44.** Regardless of the size, what do you have to give to the Kingdom? (Time, talents, finances, resources, creativity, skills, passions, etc?)

### **Doing: Application**

- Pastor Matt gave you three questions to ask yourself. As a small group discuss these question on an individual basis and then as a collective small group.
  - What am I passionate about?
  - Who is already doing something about this?
  - How can I partner with them?
